RCC BOARD OF GOVERNORS 2009 PREFERENCE POLL RESULTS

RESTON, VA - On Monday, October 19, 2009, at the request of Supervisor Catherine M. Hudgins, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors appointed three candidates to the nine-member Reston Community Center Board of Governors, all for terms expiring in 2012. The official results of the 2009 RCC Preference Poll resulted in the appointment of returning Board members William G. Bouie, Carol Ann Bradley, and Colin Mills.

"I look forward to continuing my service at RCC and am honored to have the community's trust in me to carry forward the initiatives underway and to meet the challenges of the coming year," said Carol Ann Bradley, current Chair of the RCC Board of Governors. "Congratulations to Bill Bouie and Colin Mills on their victories. I look forward to working with them on other new ventures."

Carol Ann Bradley has been on the RCC Board for the past three years and is the current Board Chair. She also serves as the Board liaison to Reston Interfaith. In previous years, Carol Ann has served as the chair of the Community Relations Committee and as a member of other Board committees.

William G. Bouie has been on the RCC Board for the past six years and is currently serving as Vice Chair. Bill is also the Board liaison to the Coalition of Reston Organizational Leadership (COROL) and the Initiative for Public Art – Reston (IPAR). He previously served as Board Chair from 2006 to 2008 and as a member of the RA/RCC Joint Task Force.

Colin Mills has been on the RCC Board for the past three years and is currently serving as Secretary. Colin is also the Board liaison to the Reston Citizens Association, where he is Vice President. He previously served on the RA/RCC Joint Task Force.

The Preference Poll Committee, led by William Penniman, conducted this year's Preference Poll using a new format. Each resident and business address of Small District 5 received a mailed ballot that they could vote online or mail-in in addition to the traditional walk-in format. This change has resulted in record-breaking voter

participation in this year's Preference Poll. The RCC Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was changed in June 2009 with approval by the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors to allow for one ballot per residential or commercial address, rather than one vote per person age 18 and older, making the new format possible.

RCC Board members set policy, adopt the operating budget, attend monthly public meetings, chairs committees, and represent RCC at community functions.
