RESTON, VA – Hank Kuhlmann presents a mixed media exhibit including artwork from his “Tiffany-Style” stained glass panels, fused stained glass designs, collages, realistic and abstract acrylic paintings, and crayon batiks. This distinctive exhibit is on display at Reston Community Center Hunters Woods until February 15, 2009.

Hank became active in stained glass upon retiring in 2000 and improved his capabilities via classes at glass shops in the area and extensive working in the

medium. In 2002 when the stained glass instructor position became available at the Reston Community Center (RCC), Hank enthusiastically accepted the job. Known for his love of teaching, Hank remains RCC’s stained glass instructor. The glass department has benefited from a consistent mix of new and experienced students (all new and experienced students are welcome). The RCC offers stained glass labs twice a month.

In 2004, Hank became interested in painting and signed up for a class. Finding painting to be fun, Hank has since has attended numerous painting and collage classes at the RCC. Nearly all have been classes led by Mike Cantwell, Karen Danenberger, Jane Ross, and Arnold Lopes. Each of these professionals has contributed much to Hank’s love of painting, technical growth, and a better ability to see multiple worlds from an artist’s point of view. Also the interaction with other students helped the creative aspect and contributed so much to Hank’s sheer joy of putting paint to canvas.
