A learning guide and weekly handouts are included in the class fee. Little Signers II is designed for children who are walking. Parent/caregiver must fully participate in the activities. 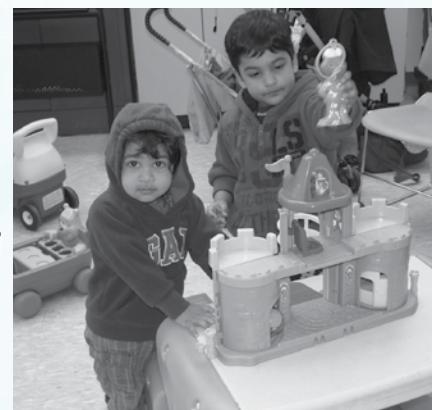
