- Performs acts or makes contributions to benefit those in need with positive and long-term impacts
- Serves the community without concern or desire for award or recognition

#### **The following categories are considered *ineligible for the award*:**

- Elected officials holding federal, state, or county office
- Schools or congregations as single entities
- Posthumous nominations
